DeckSafe Drainage Tiles

Cleaning Instructions

Sweeping, hosing down with hot water and scrubbing thoroughly as needed will remove the daily dirt and debris that may accumulate on these interlocking drain tiles. Additionally, these mats can be power washed for a more intense cleaning.

When must the mat be cleaned?

Daily to weekly, depending on usage.

How should I clean the mat?

Scrub thoroughly with a brush and rinse with hot water. Power wash as needed.

What should I use to clean the mat?

Mix mild detergent OR non-butyl degreaser with hot water.

IMPORTANT:

- DO NOT use BLEACH or any BUTYL-BASED DEGREASER regardless of where the mat is used. Usage of these chemicals will void the product warranty.
- Exposing the mat to any other chemicals may adversely affect the service of this product.
- Improper cleaning, handling, folding, or use of commercial dishwasher for cleaning mats will shorten expected useful life of the mat and may void the warranty.
- Do not use high pH detergents, alkali or solvents. The break should not exceed a pH of 9.5. Use a low pH non-ionic detergent. 2-6 oz./100 # of mats. Consult with your chemical supplier for exact amounts.
- Lay mats flat following cleaning to allow any water to drain out.
- Do not dry matting tiles in dryers.

You must follow these maintenance instructions to comply with the product warranty requirements. Failure to comply with these instructions may void the product warranty.
